Jody Armstrong, Administrator, reported the formal request to Martin County to increase the annual ROW Maintenance Agreement reimbursement to MDPOA, is on the Budget Office agenda and will go before the Board for discussion during the 2025 budget meeting.

President's Report:

President Graham advised that the MDPOA would be closed both July 4 and 5 for the Independence Day Holiday.

Old Business / New Business / Comments:

Access System Update – President Graham gave an update. Entry enhancements at Meadows are complete. The challenge continues to be getting email addresses for all the Meadows' residents. West Village and Sunset enhancements are underway. The ButterflyMX surface intercoms for West Village and Sunset were received. West Village will be the next to go live.

Review Proposed Fourth Amendment –

President Graham asked Liz Bonan to provide a review of the proposed changes to add eligibility requirements for Officers, and to enhance the election process. Bonan said she heard from several of the Committee members with good suggestions, which she used to draft the proposed Amendment. Each change and addition were discussed, and comments considered. Based on additional input, Bonan will revise the proposed Amendment to be discussed again at the next Executive Committee meeting.
